The Children's Cottage Society is a charitable agency established in Calgary in 1986. The Society's mission is "Building strong children and safe nurturing families through prevention programs and support services" and our vision is "Resilient children blossom in healthy families."

We are looking for a strong team player to join our organization as a Child Care Worker with the Crisis Nursery Program.

Reporting to the Team Lead in consultation with the Crisis Nursery Manager, the Child Care worker is responsible for day-to-day care of the children staying at the Crisis Nursery. This role assists with planning daily activities for the children according to their developmental needs.

The Child Care Worker position is combination of 12-hour day shifts and 12-hour awake night shifts.

Responsibilities:

- Providing quality care for children who are newborn to age 8.
- Maintaining a safe environment.
- Assisting children in their daily routines.
- Assisting children to cope with feelings of separation from their parents.
- Documentation of children's daily activities.

Qualifications:

- Early Childhood Certificate an asset
- Minimum of three years' experience caring for children. Must be particularly experienced caring for infants and toddlers.
- Current first aid/CPR/suicide intervention, aboriginal training, diversity training.
- Must be available to work within an environment that provides 24/7 child care.
- Must have the ability to work day shifts and awake overnight shifts and can be responsive to be called into work on short notice.
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills.

Pre-employment Requirements:

- A Police Information Check, which includes a vulnerable sector search, is required prior to employment.
- A Child Intervention Record Check is required upon commencement of employment.
- It is a condition of employment that the successful candidate be fully vaccinated for COVID-19 or satisfy criteria for a duty to accommodate in accordance with the Alberta Human Rights Act.

Hours of work: 12 hours shifts, a rotation of days and nights.
