We are looking for a strong team player to join our organization as a Child Care Worker with the Crisis Nursery Program.

Reporting to the Team Lead, in consultation with the Crisis Nursery Manager, the Child Care Worker is responsible for the day-to-day care of the children staying at the Crisis Nursery. This role assists with planning daily activities for the children according to their developmental needs.

Responsibilities:

- Providing quality care for children who are newborn to age 8.
- Maintaining a safe environment.
- Assisting children in their daily routines.
- Assisting children in coping with feelings of separation from their parents.
- Documentation of children's daily activities.

Qualifications:

- Early Childhood Certificate an asset.
- Minimum of three years' experience caring for children. Must be experienced specifically in caring for infants and toddlers.
- Current First Aid/CPR/Suicide Intervention, aboriginal training, diversity training.
- Must be available to work within an environment that provides 24/7 childcare.
- Must have the ability to work day shifts and awake overnight shifts and can be responsive to be called into work on short notice.
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills.

Hours of work: 12 hours shifts, a rotation of days and nights.
