As well, a valid First Aid certificate must be obtained within 3 months of employment and a Food Safe certificate is also required. A vehicle is required, and mileage is paid. The relief cook reports to the Food Services Coordinator.

**MAIN RESPONSIBILITIES:**

1. Prepare lunches and dinners for 45-60 residents following the Brenda's House nutrition plan.
2. Ensure sanitation and safety of kitchen.
3. Be friendly and respectful to families during their stay at Brenda's House.
4. Other responsibilities as requested by the Food Services Coordinator/Manager.
